

Rebuilding Together Restores Harris County Three Months Post-Hurricane Harvey

HOUSTON, Nov. 16, 2017 /PRNewswire/ -- The local Houston affiliate of the national non-profit Rebuilding Together has a plan to help Harris County homeowners reclaim their lives three months after Hurricane Harvey.
